

## **ANTI-SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING STATEMENT**

The Board of Directors of Farrans Construction is fully committed to and supportive of international efforts to promote ethical principles and practices related to the prevention of the exploitation and abuse associated with modern slavery and trafficking. The Board expects commitment to these principles from our supply chain and other organisations with which we do business.

We are aware of our obligations under section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 as well as the related report published by the Centre of Social Justice in 2013.

The steps we have taken recently to ensure compliance with the Act include the following:-

- enhancement of our Ethical Procurement Policy.
- introduction of a Sub-Contractor Modern Slavery Act Commitment Statement which outlines the document checking requirements for all sub-contractor employees employed on our construction sites (see attached Commitment Statement).
- regular monitoring and auditing of compliance with the requirements of the Act.

This Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement and compliance with it will be kept under review and will be amended accordingly in the light of audit findings and best practice.
